- Why?
- 200 arrests for live streaming in Dec 2017 (NCA)
- Approx. 15 internet related issues Police are dealing with per day
- Issues are that friends/strangers are blurred online with the outside world as you don't know who they say they are. Young people feel pressure from 'randoms' online requests
- Doesn't have to be physical contact but asking a young person to perform sexual act online can be just as harmful particularly if they are recorded or screen shots

Language groomers use online

Process that happens over time - usually in a sequence.

Groomer

- Small talk: 'Hey, how's things?' then they offer praise - 'You're cute'
- Exchanging personal information: 'What school you at?' 'I like to body surf in summer, what do you like doing?'

Child

'awh thnx'

'Same.'

'I'm at Hightown High.

WBU?'

Language groomers use online

Groomer

Relationship: 'what you feeling for me?'

Online Access - Entrapment Network

Isolation – physical and social isolation with family and friends, secrecy

Sexual gratification which desensitises 'Do you want to lose your virginity?'

Child

'I like you.'

Language groomers use online

It has been known that grooming can take place online in as little as 20 minutes.

Groomer

Offline Access – Reframing

Pupil/teacher framework 'I can teach you to enjoy sex.'

Compliance testing - Reverse Psychology

'If you've never had sex you're a baby.'

Then reversing role - 'Let's meet somewhere where it's safe.'

Strategic Withdrawal 'Well it's just an idea but it's up to you?'

Real Cases in Education

- 2010 -Maths Teacher groomed pupil online before having sex with her in school cupboard – jailed 15 months
- 2010 -Teacher groomed a teenage pupil online before getting her to send 'provocative' photos of herself - jailed 6 months
- 2011 Male Music teacher groomed girl set up private FB accounts and had sex – jailed 4 years
- 2015 Female teacher groomed online boy with ADHD and Dyslexia and had sex – jailed 2 years
- 2015 Female teacher send 12,000 explicit text messages to a boy in her class – jailed 4 months
- 2017 Male teacher for a top Catholic School took naked photos and sent to a female pupil, gave her drugs to enhance sex jailed for life

Grooming young people is not always for sexual gratification

- Online radicalisation and extremism is becoming more prevalent
- In Dudley average age under 15 (Most referrals are coming through schools)
- National average age is 25
 61% is international terrorism
- Lots of work to engage pupils/parents/staff
- All staff should be WRAP Prevent trained and aware of latest updates
- Know how to make referrals via SPA / CTU / LADO?

- During Dec 2017 intense work to tackle CSE and abuse, Police and National Crime Agency (NCA) operations across the UK safeguarded 245 children and arrested 192 people, 18 of whom were in a position of trust.
- 30% cases involved some of the highest harm offences including live streaming, blackmail and grooming.

CEOP Dec 2017

Role of the Designated Officer – LADO Yvonne Nelson-Brown

- Oversee allegations against individuals in a Position of Trust
- Offer consultation/advice on allegations against people in a position of trust
- Chair Position of Trust (POT) meetings
- Monitor patterns of behaviour (data base of all referrals)
- Ensures the LA complies with statutory obligations around managing allegations against individuals in a Position of Trust
- Acts/responds in a timely manner that promotes positive outcomes for C&YP
- POTs meetings relating to online incidents April 2016 March 2017 = 49 Previous financial year 2015-2016 = 10.

LADO GUIDANCE FOR PROFESSIONALS

- Does your enquiry / referral meet the Management of Allegations) criteria? As defined by working Together (2010 and 2016)
- This is defined as Where an allegation has been made whereby a person working (employed or volunteer. This also includes Foster carers and pre adoptive placements) with children may have:
- Behaved in a way that has harmed a child, or may have harmed a child
- Possibly committed an offence against or related to a child OR
 Behaved towards a child or children in a way that indicates he or she would pose a risk of harm to children.

(This could also mean their suitability to work with children)

SHOULD THE FOLLOWING SCENARIOS BE REFFERED INTO LADO?

- A parent comes into school complaining about the **Deputy Head**. She shared her daughter does not like him as he is always shouting at the kids; he has also stopped her daughter from attending a school trip.
- 2. A **Church Warden** has been giving private singing lessons to a young choirboy without other adults being present. The boy has informed his parents that he is persistently talking about sex and asking him to view pornography sites together.
- 3. A **Family Support Worker** who is off duty, bumps into a member of a family he is currently working with. She is 14. He asks if she wants a lift home but would she like to grab a coffee first?
- 4. Two female pupils inform you that on the way home from school the previous evening **two people in a car** tried to entice them to get into the car but they refused and drove off.
- 5. There is gossip going about suggesting that a **female member of staff** is involved a relationship beleaguered with violence.
- 6. A Child informs that a **Leisure Attendant** at the local swimming baths has been contacting them and other girls via WHATS APP
- 7. There is rumour going about the school that a 15 year old female pupil is engaging in a relationship with a **female Newly Qualified Teacher NQT**.

REFER TO LADO BREACH OF SAFE WORKING PRACTICES AND CODE OF CONDUCT
- A family support worker who is off duty bumps into a member of a family he is currently working. She is 14. He asks if she wants a lift home but would she like to grab a coffee with him first. REFER TO LADO BREACH OF SAFE WORKING
 PRACTICES AND CODE OF CONDUCT
- Two female pupils inform you that on the way home from school the previous evening two people in a car tried to entice them to get into the car but they refused and drove off- NO ROLE FOR THE LADO- CONSIDER CONTACTING LOCAL POLICE
- There is gossip going about suggesting that female member of staff is involved a relationship beleaguered with violence NO ROLE FOR THE LADO CONSIDER INVITING STAFF MEMBER IN FOR A CHAT, OFFER SUPPORT
- A Child informs that a leisure attendant at the local swimming baths has been contacting them via WHATS APP REFER TO LADO BREACH OF SAFE WORKING PRACTICES AND CODE OF CONDUCT
- There is rumour going about the school that a 15 year old female pupil is engaging in a relationship with a female NQT. <u>REFER TO LADO BREACH OF SAFE WORKING PRACTICES AND CODE OF CONDUCT</u>
